Gleneagle Productions LLC (Gleneagle-Productions.com) has announced the availability of an arrangement of **Arthur Foote's *Suite, Opus 63*** for Wind Ensemble. The work was originally written for string orchestra and is one of his most popular. It consists of three movements: Praeludium (allegro comodo), Capriccioso (allegretto & adagietto) and Fuge (allegro giusto).

Playing time for the piece is approximately **13'30"** and it is rated at **grade level 6 (Advanced)**. The wind & percussion arrangement calls for:

Flutes: Piccolo, 1, 2
Oboes: 1, 2, English Horn
Clarinets: E-flat, 1, 2, 3, Alto, Bass
Saxophones: Soprano, Alto 1 & 2, Tenor
Bassoons: 1, 2
Horns: 1, 2, 3, 4
Trumpets: 1, 2, 3
Trombones: 1, 2, 3 (Bass)
Euphonium/Baritone
Tuba
Timpani
Percussion: Bass Drum, Cymbals, Triangle, Snare Drum
Chimes
Marimba
Glockenspiel
Vibraphone

The arrangement retails for **\$195**. Performance packages include conductor score (tabloid size) and all parts.

According to the arranger, **Douglas Arndt**, "The *Suite* by Arthur Foote is one of the true masterpieces to emerge from the Second New England School. This arrangement is intended to expose highly proficient wind ensembles to this gem from one of America's finest composers. The *Suite's* three movements are so incredibly rich and diverse that each one can stand on its own on a program."
