Gleneagle Productions LLC (Gleneagle-Productions.com) has announced the availability of an arrangement of **Horatio Parker's *Scherzo, Opus 32 no. 3 ("Gerrit's Waltz")*** for Wind Ensemble. The work was originally written for organ as part of his *Five Sketches*.

Playing time for the piece is approximately **3' 35"** and it is rated at **grade level 4 (Medium)**. The wind & percussion arrangement calls for:

Flutes: Piccolo, 1, 2
Oboes: 1, 2
Clarinets: 1, 2, 3, Alto, Bass
Saxophones: Soprano, Alto 1 & 2, Tenor, Baritone
Bassoon
Horns: 1, 2, 3, 4
Trumpets: 1, 2, 3
Trombones: 1, 2, 3 (Bass)
Euphonium/Baritone
Tuba
Percussion: Bass Drum, Cymbals, Triangle, Snare Drum, Tambourine
Marimba
Glockenspiel
Vibraphone

The arrangement retails for **\$65**. Performance packages include conductor score and all parts.

This piece is lively and is in rondo form. It is perfect for many concert formats and themes. It is especially well-suited for pops concerts and can be the ideal encore piece.
